Government issued photo ID will be used upon your visit to complete your registration into our system.



Insurance card will be used to validate the information given to us.

Any outside reports (pathology, CT scan, Bone scan, mammogram, etc.)



We welcome your questions (any questions you might want to ask your doctor or nurse while you are being seen)



Our receptionist will call you to confirm your appointment, at which point you will be reminded of all you need to bring. Make sure you have our phone number handy; if you lose your way, please give us a call and we will help guide you to our location. Also we have red coat volunteers available to assist you in finding your way to us. They are located by the 68th street entrance information desk.

Once you are in our office, you will be asked to fill out paperwork; there may be a short wait, then a nurse will come and direct you to an exam room where you will be seen by the doctor. The nurse will inform you of what to expect from that point on. If you wish to have a family member or your significant other informed, they may accompany you on your visit.
